Antrim County County Research Guide: No. 5

Antrim County was organized as Megesee County in 1840. The name was changed to Antrim in 1843. The county coordinates are Range 5W-9W and Township 29N-32N. Adjacent counties include Charlevoix (north), Otsego (east), Crawford (southeast), Kalkaska (south), Grand Traverse (southwest), and Leelanau (west).
