


# Archives of Michigan



## **Lenawee County** County Research Guide: No. 46

Lenawee County was organized in 1826. The county coordinates are Range 1E-5E and Township 5S-48. Adjacent counties include Hillsdale (west), Monroe (east), Jackson (northwest), Washtenaw (northeast), Lucas County, Ohio (southeast), and Fulton County, Ohio (southwest).
