

Montmorency County



Montmorency County was originally laid off in 1840 as Cheonoquet County, but was later officially organized in 1881. The county coordinates are Range 1E-4E and Township 29N-32N. Adjacent counties include Presque Isle (northeast), Alpena (east), Alcona (southeast), Oscoda (south), Crawford (southwest), Otsego (west), and Cheboygan (northwest).
