



Menominee County

First organized in 1861 as Bleeker County, Menominee County was reorganized and renamed in 1863 as Menominee County. The county coordinates are Range 24W-29W and Township 31N-41N. Adjacent counties include Marquette (north), Delta (northeast), Marinette [WI] (west), and Dickinson (northwest).
