

## Hillsdale County



Hillsdale County was set off in 1829 and formally organized in 1835. The county coordinates are Range 1W–4W and Township 5S–9S. Adjacent counties include Jackson (north), Lenawee (east), Fulton [OH] (southeast), Williams [OH] (south), and Steuben [IN] (southwest), Branch (west), and Calhoun (northwest).
