

Missaukee County



Missaukee County was originally laid off in 1840, but was later officially organized in 1871. The county coordinates are Range 5W-8W and Township 21N-24N. Adjacent counties include Kalkaska (north), Crawford (northeast), Roscommon (east), Clare (southeast), Osceola (southwest), Wexford (west), and Grand Traverse (northwest).
