

Gladwin County



Gladwin County was originally laid off in 1831, but was later officially organized in 1875. The county coordinates are Range 2W-2E and Township 17N-20N. Adjacent counties include Roscommon (northwest), Ogemaw (northeast), Arenac (east), Bay (southeast), Saginaw (south), Isabella (southwest), and Clare (west).
