Thomas J Rogers residing in the city of Louisville, Kentucky, states that he was acquainted with Thornton a mulatto man who was hired to Wurts and Reinhard, that he the said Rogers had left Louisville in the fall of 1830 and was in the fall of 1831 in Detroit Michigan Territory, while then he saw and conversed with Thornton and knew him to be the same porter who was in the employment of Wurts and Reinhard, as a hired slave, that Thornton told him he had his wife in Detroit with him.
