A copy of the twenty-eighth section of an act of the General Assembly of the common Wealth of Kentucky entitled, "An Act to reduce into one, the several acts respecting slave, free Negroes, mulattos and Indians" approved February the eighth, one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight.

Section 28. All Negro, mulattos, or Indian slaves in all courts of Judication and other places within this common wealth shall be held, taken and adjudged to be real estate, and shall descend to the heirs and widows of persons departing this life as lands are directed to descend in and by an act of the General Assembly entitled, "An Act directing the course of descents."
