Knows the signature of Susan Brown, attached to the power of attorney exhibited to be that of the said Susan Brown and that Benjamin G Weir therein named and constituted the attorney of the said Sarah Brown and Virgil McKnight is the same person now present. The deponent further says that he does not know Ruthy Blackburn, not that the person arrested and here present is the person claimed as the slave of Virgil McKnight and e further saith that he saw Virgil McKnight deliver the power of attorney to deponents father John P. Oldham for the said Weir to whom deponents father deliver it.

Benjamin G. Weir deposeseth and saith that he has seen Thornton Blackburn in Louisville, Kentucky in the employment of Wurts and Reinhard as a porter, but does not know from his own knowledge that he is a slave. That he knows the hand writing of John P. Oldham and that he knows the signature of the said Oldham attached to the paper exhibited to be that of the said Oldham but does not know the signature of Thomas J Rogers there unto affixed, that he knows that John C Bueklin is the mayor of the city of Louisville in the State of Kentucky and that his signature to the said writing is the hand writing. That the said Mayor is authorized by the law of Kentucky to administer oath and that the seal attached thereto is the seal of the mayor of the said city and that the Mayor only is permitted to use the said seal, and that the clerk of the said court is not authorized to affix the same. He further says he never saw Ruthy Blackburn and cannot say whether the

woman arrested by that name and here presented is that person or that she is the slave or property of Virgil McKnight.
