

Ogemaw County



Ogemaw County was originally laid off in 1840, but was later officially organized in 1875. The county coordinates are Range 1E-4E and Township 21N-24N. Adjacent counties include Oscoda (north), Alcona (northeast), Iosco (east), Arenac (southeast), Gladwin (southwest), Roscommon (west), and Crawford (northwest).
